

HOW TO ORGANISE YOUR FUNDRAISER

1 Choose your location

Think about what sort of venue you need. Will it be online or in person? In your home or in another venue? Can you use your church, village hall or school hall? If it's online, which platform will you use?

2 Put a date in the diary

3 Get friends and family involved

4 <u>Set up your fundraising page</u>

A JustGiving page is quick and easy to set up. Make sure you select Open Doors as your charity and the money you raise for the persecuted church will automatically be sent to Open Doors without you needing to do a thing.

5 <u>Promote your event</u>

Social media is a great way to do this - but it's not the only way. Try speaking about your challenge in church, putting up posters in your community or contacting your local newspaper. And remember, we have lots of resources to help you.
