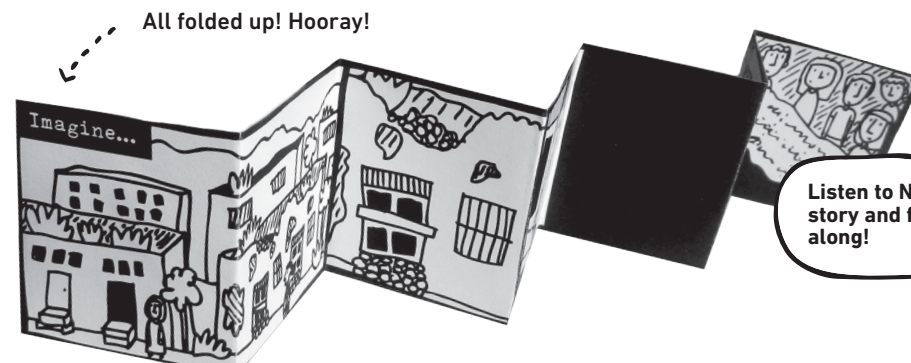
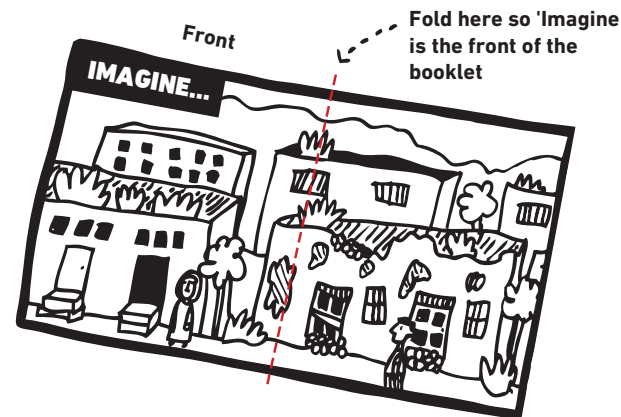
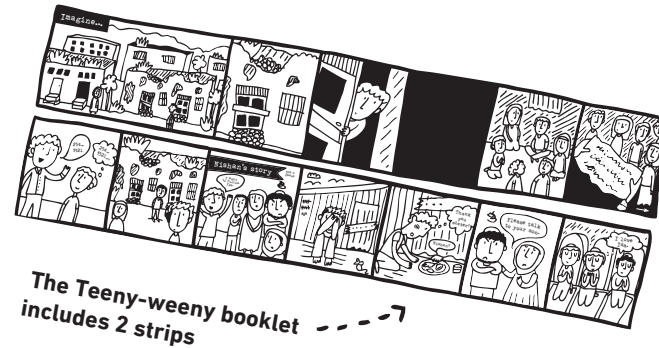


# How to make your Teeny-weeny booklet!

1. **Read** through the Teeny-weeny booklet (page 2). There are two strips of the booklet on the page.
2. **Cut** the page in half and give one to a friend or sibling to make.
3. **Ask** a friend or parent to help when needed.
4. **Colour** in both strips – with coloured pens, pencils, crayons or whatever you like.
5. **Cut** around each strip as carefully as you can.
6. **Glue** the two sides together: glue the first part (starting with 'Imagine') to the back of the second strip – so they read left to right (even when turning over the strip). They won't exactly match, but don't worry.
7. **Fold** so that 'Imagine' is the first box.
8. **Fold** in accordion style along the black lines.
9. **Don't worry** if it's a bit wobbly.
10. **Your Teeny-weeny booklet is complete!** Amazing work!
11. **Listen** to the Audio Montages online to discover more about Nishan's story.
